

Dato VK loves golf. Striding away the clubs sending the ball high up to the sky, he loves the serenity of the game. It made him feel closer towards nature. One bad golfing incident had caused him teeth. Not a nice sight for a reputed golfer, sitting among the ministers during conferences, director meetings, and luxurious high teas.

His secretary called in one morning, making a dental appointment for him. The story narrated by his secretary was not so detailed, so we decided to take a closer look at his dental condition.



The damage was bad. The golf ball was cruel enough to destroy most of his upper teeth. The blow was severe, causing him a couple of laceration wounds, and fractured teeth. We decided to take his teeth to the next level.

A full OPG X-ray was done for him, recording his intraoral dental condition. Radiographic imaging is vital for reconstruction cases like this.



After the laceration wounds were treated, the damage teeth were next to treat. A couple of root canal treatments were carried on the fractured upper teeth, rebuilding the tooth with a fiber post and strong composite core; preparing Dato K. for his incoming new crowns. A new bite had to be created due to loss of his occlusion during that unfortunate incident. A full set of Zicornia crowns were constructed to fit Dato's new set of treated teeth.



The installation of the crowns went very smoothly. Dato K. was given his new set of diamond-like teeth within a time frame of less than 3 weeks. He looked much better, younger and happier with them. Nothing come close than loosing your precious teeth over an accident, and having them replaced within a short time frame.
